CASE INFORMATION

Statement of Claim filed on or about: June 4, 2003.

Claimants signed the Uniform Submission Agreement: May 30, 2003. Statement of Answer filed by Respondents on or about: August 25, 2003. Respondent Amex signed the Uniform Submission Agreement: June 27, 2003. Respondent Leap signed the Uniform Submission Agreement: July 29, 2003.

CASE SUMMARY

Claimants asserted the following causes of action: unsuitability; fraudulent and negligent misrepresentation; failure to disclose; violation of Florida Statutes Chapter 517; and, negligence. The causes of action relate to Respondents' alleged failure to maintain suitable investments and the purchase of various shares of common stock, limited partnerships, and mutual funds, annuities, real estate investments, and certificates of deposit in Claimants' account including: New Dimensions Class B, Cash Management Class A, Equity Value Class B, Flexible Annuity, and Corporate Property Associates 14.

Unless specifically admitted in their Answer, Respondents denied the allegations made in the Statement of Claim and asserted various affirmative defenses.

RELIEF REQUESTED

Claimants requested compensatory damages of \$246,250.00, punitive damages of \$100,000.00, pre-judgment interest, attorneys' fees pursuant to Florida Statutes Chapter 517, and costs.

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Respondents requested dismissal of the Statement of Claim, costs, attorneys' fees as the "prevailing party" to be awarded by a court of competent jurisdiction consistent with Florida law, and such other relief as the undersigned arbitrators (the "Panel") deemed just and proper.

OTHER ISSUES CONSIDERED AND DECIDED

The parties agreed that the Award in this matter may be executed in counterpart copies or that a handwritten, signed Award may be entered.

AWARD

After considering the pleadings, the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, and the post-hearing submissions (if any), the Panel has decided in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

Claimants' Statement of Claim is dismissed, with prejudice.

The Panel finds it would be unjust to award attorneys' fees to either party under Florida Statutes §517.301. Accordingly, the parties' requests for attorneys' fees are denied.

Claimants' claims for relief pursuant to Florida Statutes Chapter 517 are denied.

The Panel recommends the expungement of all references to the above-captioned arbitration from Respondent Leap's registration records maintained by the NASD Central Registration Depository ("CRD"), with the understanding that pursuant to NASD Notices to Members 99-09 and 99-54, Respondent Leap must obtain confirmation from a court of competent jurisdiction before the CRD will execute the expungement directive.

Any and all claims for relief not specifically addressed herein, including Claimants' request for punitive damages, are denied.

FEES

Pursuant to the NASD Code of Arbitration Procedure (the "Code"), the following fees are assessed:

NASD Dispute Resolution will retain or collect the non-refundable filing fees for each claim: Initial claim filing fee =\$ 300.00

Member fees are assessed to each member firm that is a party in these proceedings or to the member firm(s) that employed the associated person(s) at the time of the event(s) giving rise to the dispute. Accordingly, Respondent Amex is a member firm and a party.

Injunctive Relief Fees

Injunctive relief fees are assessed to each member or associated person who files for a temporary injunction in court. Parties in these cases are also assessed arbitrator travel expenses and costs when an arbitrator is required to travel outside his or her hearing location and additional arbitrator honoraria for the hearing for permanent injunction. These fees, except the injunctive relief surcharge, are assessed equally against each party unless otherwise directed by the panel.

No injunctive relief fees were assessed during these proceedings.
